<p>4. Data Review (10 minutes)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Absenteeism: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The school is still ranked #1 middle school attendance: 96.75 (97%). At sick time, attendance rate was 95%. - Chronic absences: 6% (unverified), only 1% of student absences unverified. - These absences are tied to students who are enrolled at Standley Middle (to keep track of access to files) but are not physically attending school. These students are taking online and IEP classes. Even if students are attending charter or private schools, they are entitled to special education rights. Students enrolled for attending school online, are mainly from the neighbourhood. <p><i>[category of students affecting the attendance system explained above.]</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suspension: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Currently, there are 75 incidents in powerschool. In year 22-23 there was 195 incidents. In year 21-22 there was 248 incidents. - Currently, there are 19 suspensions (equal to 31 days). This is approximately 2% the student population. One percent of students are suspended more than once (that is approx. 2 students). <p>Note: Standley Middle does not hold suspension to try to meet school goals.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • California Dashboard: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Suspensions show on the CA dashboard. - Data on the CA dashboard shared and discussed. - Goal of every school is to be in the blue and green zones. - Data comparing previous to current year shown and discussed. The data compares the school against itself and does not compare to other schools or other states. There is improvement in all areas. - CA distinguished received, it is an honor! - The school uses data on dashboard to be informed about how & where to set its goals. - There are no groups in the red and orange zones (e.g, ELs). - Data may be checked against the state, too (there is a student tab, and state tab). 	<p>Informational</p>

Current budget is shared & dicussed (some money will be moved around to do balances). ○ LCFF: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Reviewed and discussed • District Budget Update: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -A. Chahal had a question about the district budget cuts, that will take effect in the 24-25 school year. Mr. Pearson explained that budget cuts will impact staffing, but not the students (in terms of student enrollement). Some staffing positions may be removed and the district made effort not to impact schools and classrooms. Staffing movement/elimination are mainly in the distric central office, i.e the number of staffing positions in the school will not change ,but people occupying those position in the school may change. -Spending freeze possibilities are discussed: title 1funds cannot be freezed, LCFF and discretionary can be freezed.
